Benefits due and payable are amounts owed to program recipients or medical service providers as of September 30, 2023 that have not been paid. HHS had an increase in entitlement benefits of \$18.3 billion or 13 percent over FY 2022 that was due to an increase in medical services and claims incurred but not reported.
